- Set limits on future research you don't organize

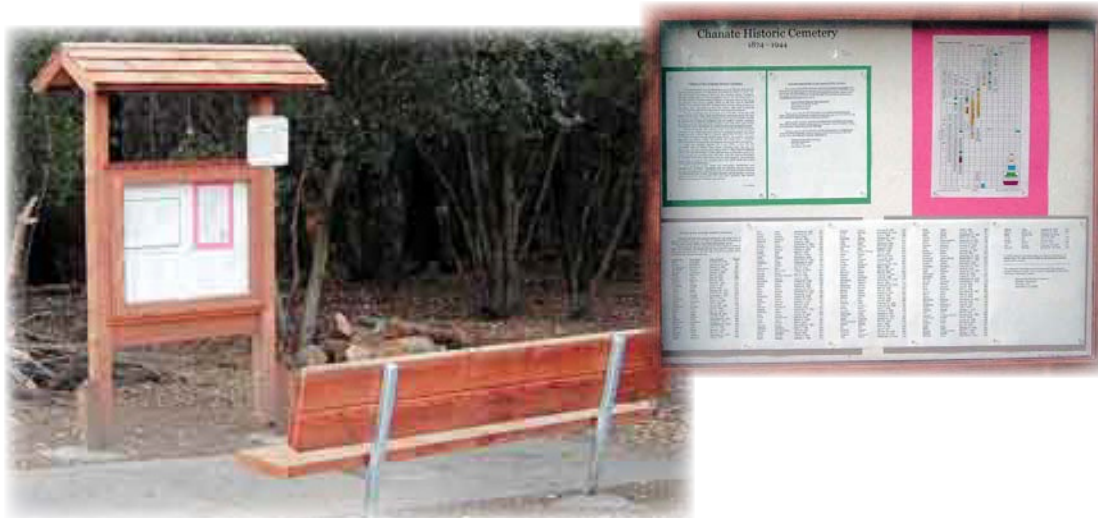
